



## **The Upcoming Vote on a Dues Increase Opting Between Voting Electronically or by Casting a Paper Ballot**

Many members have experienced difficulties receiving electronic communications from CAPE, particularly when that communication contains links to ballots or surveys. To circumvent these issues, and to attempt to eliminate the frustration experienced by CAPE members who are engaged in the process and wish to participate, the National Executive Committee has instructed the CAPE National Office to provide all CAPE members the choice of voting electronically or by using a paper ballot.

If you would prefer to vote using a paper ballot, we ask you to communicate this preference to the CAPE National Office by e-mailing [ecomunications@acep-cape.ca](mailto:ecomunications@acep-cape.ca) and providing us with your current home address.

CAPE will then ensure that you do not receive an electronic ballot, and will issue a paper ballot to your home address.

Ballots will be issued on June 3, 2013 and the voting period ends on June 20, 2013 at 4:00 EDT. If you do prefer to receive a paper ballot, the sooner you advise us, the sooner we will be able to make the necessary arrangements.

Please note, however, that should you prefer to vote electronically, and then find that your attempt to vote is frustrated, or that you have not received an electronic ballot the week of June 3, you may contact the National Office, again at [ecomunications@acep-cape.ca](mailto:ecomunications@acep-cape.ca), during the voting period, but no later than June 12, 2013 to request a paper ballot.

**All ballots, both electronic and paper must be received by the National Office no later than 4:00 p.m. EDT on June 20, 2013.**
